<p><b>MAAPP:</b> <b>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</b></p>	<p><b>This meet will adhere to the current Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”) set forth by USA Swimming.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>● A USA Swimming club that hosts a sanctioned USA Swimming swim meet indicates acknowledgement of USA Swimming’s Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”).</li> <li>● All USA Swimming members including athletes 18 and older and adults who interact with minor athletes at swim meets are expected to comply with the MAAPP policy.</li> <li>● All chaperones, team managers, adult swimmers, meet directors, officials, and non-member parents and meet volunteers are expected to understand and comply with MAAPP.</li> <li>● As the host club, you are responsible for ensuring that these individuals know about and comply with MAAPP.</li> </ul>
<p><b>ELIGIBILITY FOR TIME RECOGNITION TO THE SWIMS DATABASE</b></p>	<p><b>Effective September 1, 2022</b>, there will <b>NO</b> longer be a 30-day administrative grace period. Going forward, ANY 17-year-old athlete who has not completed the APT requirements by their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday <b>WILL NOT</b> be a USA Swimming member in good standing unless or until the APT requirement is completed. This includes eligibility to compete in USA Swimming sanctioned meets, club practices and all other related activities. Athletes will</p>

	continue to receive an email notification reminder of the APT requirement 30 days prior to their 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday as well as a reminder on their 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday. ALL I+USA Swimming members aged 18 years old and older are required to complete APT annually. This is the individual's responsibility and includes both athlete and non-athlete members.
<b>REPORT DISCRIMINATION:</b>  <b>D, E, &amp; I = Reference / Informational Section</b>	The Georgia LSC believes that there is no place for discrimination in the sport of swimming. The pool will use Colorado timing and scoreboard. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The certification is on file with USA Swimming, Inc., and Georgia Swimming, Inc.  The 10 lane, 25-yard indoor pool will be used for warm-up/recovery.
<b>MEDICAL SUPERVISION:</b>	Lifeguards will be on duty during the course of the meet. Paramedics will also be stationed in the facility.  Portable oxygen tanks and an AED are available in case of emergencies.

<b>MEET FORMAT:</b>	<p>This is a Timed Final Meet in Long Course Meters (LCM). Events will run in numerical order. All heats will run from fastest seeded to slowest seeded.</p> <p><b><u>NT-</u></b> No Time (NT) will not be accepted for races 200 meters or longer.</p> <p><b><u>Friday Night Events-</u></b> Athletes may participate in a maximum of two (2) events-The 50 Free and ONLY one of the following: 400 Freestyle, 400 IM, or 800 Freestyle. 400 Freestyle and 800 Freestyle athletes are asked to provide a timer and counter</p> <p><b><u>Saturday/Sunday Events-</u></b> athletes may participate in a maximum of three (3) events.</p> <p><b><u>Timeline Management-</u></b> Due to time constraints, these changes may be implemented. Teams will be notified no later than five days prior to the start of competition of any change. These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Chase starts (odd heats will start from the scoreboard end, and even heats will start from the far end).</li> <li>● Athlete cap on distance races (400m and longer)</li> <li>● Two athletes per lane for distance free events (400m and longer)</li> <li>● Merge events within each session to mixed gender.</li> <li>● Enforce positive check-in for 12&amp;U athletes</li> <li>● Expand positive check-in to include all events 200m or longer.</li> </ul> <p>Due to time constraints and athlete count, <u>events may be combined to allow mixed gender heats</u>. Athletes and their families will be notified no later than two days prior to the start of competition.</p> <p>NTs will not be accepted for events 200 meters and longer.</p> <p>Dive-over starts, chase starts, and two swimmers per lane for distance free events may be utilized at the discretion of meet management if the timeline warrants it.</p> <p><b><u>Breaks-</u></b> to ensure proper swimmer rest, breaks may be inserted in between events. This will be determined once an initial timeline is established. Any added breaks will be communicated prior to the start of the meet and reflected in the final timeline.</p>

<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	<p><b>OPEN MEET</b></p> <p>This meet will be conducted as defined above. All <b>2024</b> swimmers registered with USA Swimming and/or their respective World Aquatics Federation, in good standing with their local national federation, will be allowed to compete.</p> <p>All foreign delegations must submit documentation from their federation indicating athletes, coaches, and team support are members in good standing of their World Aquatics affiliated federation. “Host Club” will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials, or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.</p>
<b>ENTRIES:</b>	<p>Maximum eight (8) events for the meet- two (2) Friday, three (3) Saturday, and (3) Sunday</p> <p>See entry submission for deadlines. Deck entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director/Meet Referee, if there are empty lanes; <u>no new heats will be added.</u></p>
<b>CHECK IN:</b>	<p>Check-in is required for all events 400 yards and longer.</p>
<b>CLERK of COURSE:</b>	<p>Check-in closes thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the respective session.</p>
<b>ENTRY SUBMISSION:</b>	<p><b>Submit one check payable to: <u>Dynamo Parents’ Club</u></b>  <b>Initial Entries are due <u>Wednesday, May 1, 2024, at 8:00PM.</u></b>  <b>Email entries to Meet Director: <a href="mailto:meetdirector@dynamoswimclub.com">meetdirector@dynamoswimclub.com</a></b></p> <p>Corrections will be accepted until <b><u>Saturday, May 4, 2024, at 12:00PM.</u></b> All entries after this will be considered “late” and charged the late fee.</p> <p>Submit entries using Hy-Tek team manager. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club Code and each swimmer’s USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time for each event entered.</p>
<b>RULES:</b>	<p><b>Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.</b></p> <p><b><u>Tech Suit Restrictions for 12-and-Under Swimmers</u></b>  (Note: WOVEN FABRIC-A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.)  (Note: KNIT FABRIC-A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.)</p> <p>This rule is in effect for all USA Swimming competitions in the United States, so any manufacturer or vendor selling a suit in the United States is subject to the above rule. No Technical Suits may be worn by any 12-Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.</p> <p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, behind the blocks (Including warm-up, warm-down, and Competition), rest rooms or locker rooms.</p>

	<p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p> <p><b>Deck changes are prohibited.</b> (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.</p> <p>On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program &amp; Events Committee Chair, or designee.</p> <p>All referees, starters, administrative officials, chief judges, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event, must be non-athlete members of USA Swimming or members of other World Aquatics-member organizations. All meet directors for meets sanctioned by USA Swimming must be members of USA Swimming. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be coach members of USA Swimming.</p> <p>Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.</p> <p>Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy must be under the supervision of their own coach or a USA Swimming member coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in deciding for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.</p>
<p><b>USA SWIMMING MEMBER VERIFICATION:</b></p>	<p><b>As of September 2022, Deck Pass and Deck Pass Plus are no longer available.</b> To access USA Swimming member benefits, including your USA Swimming member card, download the USA Swimming app. Present this card to verify your USA-S and GA LSC credentials are in good standing.</p>
<p><b>COACHES:</b> <b>COACHES MEETING:</b></p>	<p>Coaches will be required to sign in at the Clerk of Course desk to verify their credentials, via SWIMS 3.0, are in good standing with USA-S and their respective LSC.</p> <p>If warranted, a coaches' meeting will be held on Zoom on Thursday, May 9 on Zoom. Information will be communicated that week.</p>

<b>OFFICIALS:</b>	<p>“Host Club” welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. Certified Officials or Apprentices wishing to work this meet may contact the Meet Referee: Doug Kintz/<a href="mailto:cdkintz@earthlink.net">cdkintz@earthlink.net</a></p> <p>There will be an official’s meeting <b>45 minutes</b> prior to the start of each session.</p> <p>The official’s uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and white shoes.</p> <p>All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; <b>OR</b> a recently completed Apprentice Form; <b>AND</b> proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.</p>
<b>MEET COMMITTEE / MEET JURY:</b>	The Meet Committee / Meet Jury shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, 2 Coaches, and 1 athlete member, as appropriate.
