3157 Damascus Road Augusta, GA 30909 706-261-0424: This facility's competition pool is a 16 lane, 25-yard pool with Colorado Timing System and scoreboard. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The certification is on file with USA Swimming, Inc., and Georgia Swimming, Inc. The pool depth at the start end equals 7-9 ft and turn end depth equals 7-9 ft. 6 warm-up lanes will be available. **SCHEDULE:** Friday Session 1: Warm-up 3:45pm - 4:50pm; start 5:00pm Saturday Session 2: Warm-up 7:00am - 8:20am; start 8:30am Session 3: Warm-up not before 12:00pm; start not before 1:00pm Session 4: Warm-up not before 4:30pm; start not before 5:30pm Sunday • Session 5: Warm up 7:00am - 8:20am; start 8:30am Session 6: Warm up not before 12:00pm; start not before 1:00pm Session 7: Warm up not before 4:00pm; start not before 5:00pm ** **Please note this is earlier than the Saturday evening session** **MEET FORMAT:** SCY • All events in the Friday evening session and all relays will be timed finals • For all other events, this will be a timed finals meet for swimmers ten (10) years old and younger and a prelims/finals meet for swimmers eleven (11) years old and older. • The top 16 swimmers in each prelim event will return for finals to swim in Championship (A) and Consolation (B) heats. A Finals will swim first to ensure a full heat. All relays will be contested in the prelim sessions as timed finals • All preliminary events and all other timed finals events will be swum slowto-fast. All finals will be swum fast-to-slow ("A" then "B" heat of each event). • With the exception of the 400 Individual Medley, 500 Freestyle and 1650 Freestyle events, all events will be pre-seeded. The 400 Individual Medley, 500 Freestyle and 1650 Freestyle events will require positive check in and will be deck seeded. These three events will be swum fast-to-slow. All swimmers in the 500 Freestyle & 1650 Freestyle event should provide someone to count laps, if desired. We reserve the right to limit the 1650 FR to 2 heats of each gender. Meet management also reserves the right to combine events as needed to maintain reasonable and allowable timelines. Two pools are anticipated being used for this competition. The lane configuration and pool assignments will be made once all entries have been received so that reasonable and allowable timelines can be achieved. Whistle and no-recall starts will be used; dive-over starts will be used.

Coaches should make sure their swimmers understand these protocols.

OPEN to all USA-registered swimmers and teams in the Northeast Division of Georgia Swimming LSC: ABSC, ASL, BAY, GA, GAS, HRST, LA, MORG, NGR, ROCK, SHOC, SUMM, WW Aiken-Augusta Swim League will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. If a swimmer who is not properly registered with USA Swimming competes in a sanctioned competition, the host LSC may impose a fine up to \$100.00 per event against the individual, member coach or member club submitting the entry.
Entries will be limited to the first 750 swimmers, including the Host Team's swimmers, that have submitted all required documentation and fees by the meet deadline. If a non-host team's entries cause the limit to be exceeded, all entries for that team will be accepted.
Any swimmer participating in only timed finals events in a given day may swim a maximum of six (6) individual events that day. Any swimmer participating in at least one (1) prelims/finals event in a given day may swim a maximum of three (3) individual events that day.
Deck entries can be made with the Clerk of Course up to 30 minutes before the start of the session. Late entries will be permitted only if open lanes are available. No additional heats will be created in pre-seeded events. The 500 FR, 1650 FR & 400 IM will require positive check in and will be deck seeded. If a limit of swimmers is set by meet management for deck seeded events, any swimmers originally entered who are not allowed to be seeded shall be allowed to substitute a different event.
ENTRY DEADLINE: Date: March 13, 2020 Time: 9:00 PM Submit entries using Hy-Tek team manager. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club Code and each swimmer's USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time for each event entered.
Georgia Swimming Tech Suit Policy - refer to www.gaswim.org Select: Meets/Events from the home page to review full policy Revised: Effective April 1, 2019: In all Georgia Swimming Sanctioned or Approved competitions, the use of Tech Suits as defined below will NOT be allowed by any 12&Under athletes (whether competing in age-specific or "Open" events). 11-12 swimmers only will be allowed to wear Tech Suits at meets determined as Championship meets in the LSC such as Divisionals, State Championships, and Age Group Sectionals Note: This meet is designated a Championship Meet by the Georgia LSC. The following applies:

8.2 Competitions that meet the criteria laid out in 8.1 shall be considered "Championship Meets" and therefore the following rules shall apply: 8.2.2 Use of technical suits by 11&12-year-old swimmers will be allowed.

Current USA Swimming Technical Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck changes are prohibited. (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.

On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program & Events Committee Chair or designee.

Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.

Swimmers will be responsible for swimming in their assigned heat and lane.

Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.

Swimmers entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a member coach must report to the Meet Referee or Meet Director, prior to the beginning of swimming activities to arrange for coach supervision of warm up, competition and warm down during the meet.

COACHES:

Coaches will be required to sign in and show their USA Swimming coaches registration card or **DECK PASS** for verification that all certifications are current.

COACHES MEETING:	COACHES MEETING: Friday, March 20, at 3:30 PM
OFFICIALS:	Aiken-Augusta Swim League welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. There will be an official's meeting 45 min. prior to the start of each session. The official's uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and shoes. All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; OR a recently completed Apprentice Form; AND proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.
MEET COMMITTEE:	The Meet Committee shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, Coaches and athlete members, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2019 USA Swimming Rulebook)
HOSPITALITY	Hospitality will be provided for eligible individuals, i.e. coaches, officials.
AWARDS:	Medals will be given to the top 3 finishers in each individual event and the top finisher in each relay event. Ribbons will be given for the $4^{th} - 8^{th}$ finishers in individual events and 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} finishers in relay events.
	Team Awards will be given for 1 st through 3 rd place.
	An award will be given to the Northeastern Division club showing the most team spirit. A 5-member spirit award committee comprised of coaches, officials and pool staff will be selected at the beginning of the meet. Their decision on the winner of the award will be announced at Sunday evening's finals session.
